
Did you know that A-Basin, Colorado and Loveland Basin, Colorado ski areas both opened in October? The La Nina weather pattern that is blamed for the Texas drought brought rec-

ord snowfall to Colorado last year and La Nina is back again for another ski season. The National Weather Service is not going out on a limb and predicting back-to-back record snowfall years for Colorado, saying it may only be an "average" snowfall year in Colorado. Average? Average for Colorado is GOOD! The National Weather Service did say the ski areas to the north - Whistler, Banff & Sun Valley - were likely to get hammered again. That is good news for Space City Ski Club members signed up for Banff and Sun Valley! Following is the status of our ski trips:

VAIL - Our Vail trip in December has limited space on both the long trip and short trip. Time is definitely running out for people to sign up for Vail!

Banff, Canada - The November general meeting may be your last chance to sign up for our trip to Banff. We are offering a great airline connection (direct non-stop to Calgary) and a trip price that is competitive with other ski trips on our slate. Stay in Banff Aspen Lodge with breakfast included, then have the option to ski each day at Sunshine Village, Lake Louise or Banff Mt. Norquay. Or if you prefer not to ski, Banff Aspen Lodge is located two blocks from downtown; close to shopping, galleries and many fine restaurants

Breckenridge/Keystone - Our Breckenridge (short trip) and Breckenridge/Keystone (long trip) is still available as either a short trip or long trip. Both full packages and land packages are availa-
