Please mark your calendar for Monday, November 12<sup>th</sup> and plan to join us at the HESS Club for our General Meeting. Also, invite a friend!


## **Countdown to Liftoff**



#### USERID/PASSWORD HELP

The most common questions this month were "I forgot my password" and "what's my userid?" On the new website, you can retrieve your userid and you can reset your password. I've created a video on the website to show you how to do this.

To find helpful website video tips on the website as they are created:

Click on ABOUT US, and then WEBSITE TIPS



PLAY the video you are interested in (there's just one currently)

### SIGNING UP ONLINE FOR TRIP OPTIONS, SUCH AS LIFT TICKETS

The new website allows you to choose your trip options. For example, you've made a deposit on the Taos Ski Trip and want to purchase your lift tickets. Sign up for Taos Ski Trip Options and you can select your ski tickets, Ski week (if you purchase a 6-day lift ticket), and choose whether you wish to join the group dinner. Using this online sign-up will really help your TC.

Currently we only accept checks for trip options – just follow the mailing directions the website provides.

#### THE FINANCIAL ADVANTAGE OF SIGNING ON

If an event that has different pricing for members and non-members, you have to sign-on to take advantage of the member pricing. We're going to mark all the activities with this dual pricing with this icon:

It's super easy to have have the website AUTOMATICALLY sign you on, so you won't have to remember to do so each time...and you'll get the special member pricing each time. Just click the 'remember me' box on the member login when, then click the 'Login' button. If you change browsers or delete all your cookies, you will have to set this up again.
