

It's almost time to pick a ski trip for the upcoming ski season. I know the VP of Trips, DOTs, TCs and ATCs have been very busy organizing everything. The activity coordinators are also busy planning new activities. Kim and I do have some activities we would like to offer, but we do not have any people to run them, sooooo help me help you by calling or emailing Kim or me. Activities are easy to run and we have a good support staff to answer questions

Did you know....

That the ballroom we meet in every month is not "free". We have a bar minimum we need to meet to "pay" for the room. This is how it works. Every month, we have to have a bar tab of \$900 in order to make the ballroom "free". The catch is, the only drinks they count are the ones that are sold at the bars at the entrance to the club meeting and the bar in the ballroom. They DO NOT count any drinks that are purchased at the Hotel Bar toward that total. If we do not meet the \$900 minimum for that evening, the club has to pay the difference, i.e. your club dollars are going toward the payment for the room. For example: Our goal is \$900

Bar at the entrance sells \$500 Bar inside the room sells \$250 Total sold: \$750 SCSC pays out of its bank account \$150.

How can we help

Buy your drinks at the drink bars set up for SCSC and not at the hotel bar. This will help pay for the meeting room. Thank you.






