Dates: Depart Houston 11:30 p.m. Wednesday, December 27 via Braniff Arrive Denver 1:33 a.m. Arrive Vail 6:00 a.m. (approx.)

Depart Vail (approx.) 6:00 p.m. Monday, January 1, 196%, Depart Denver 2:30 a.m. January 2 Arrive Houston 6:15 a.m.

Accommodations:

Dormitory style-The Short Swing Inn 4 to a room with lockers for each person Showers and restrooms centrally located on each floor.

Trip Cost:

The cost of the trip including transportation and lodging will be between \$120 and \$140 depending upon the type of air transportation available.

Deposits:

\$50 deposit required upon signing up or by the Oct. 9 meeting

The balance of the trip will be due on or before November 20. All deposits may be refundable up to December 1, 1967. The balance of the trip will either be \$70 or \$90.

Ski Rentals:

\$ 6.00 \$ 9.00	Boots (Lace) for 1 week Boots (Buckle) for 1 week
\$17.50	Head Standards and Poles only for 1 week

\$6.50 per day or \$32.50 for 5 days
