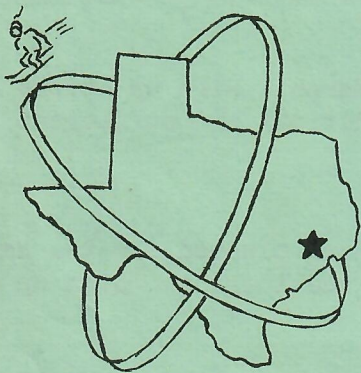
"School Teacher Special"

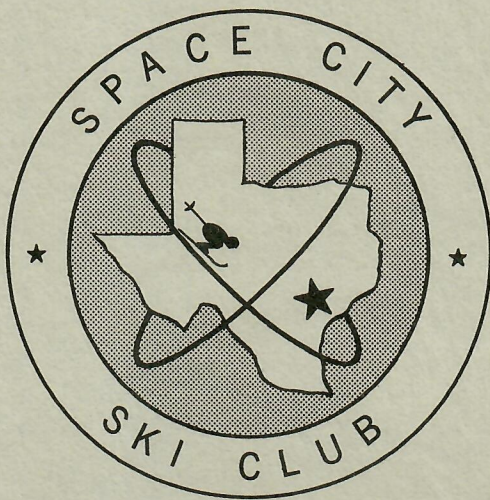

1. Departure from ~~Houston Air Center~~. Check in time 4:30 A.M. Flight leaves 5:00 A.M. sharp! Limit on luggage; two bags, total weight not to exceed 45 lbs., excluding skis, boots and poles. People should double up as much as possible in cars going out to ~~Houston Air Center~~ **AIRPORT**.

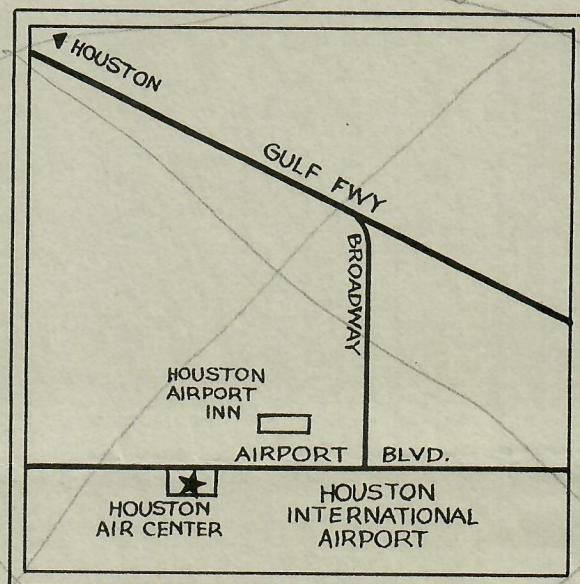

2. A "first-class" breakfast will be served during the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ -hour flight from Houston to Denver. We will arrive at the ~~Combs Aviation Terminal~~ *Grand Junction* at Stapleton Airport in Denver at approximately 7:00 A.M. (Mountain Standard Time) at which time we will board buses and cars and go immediately to Aspen. There will be a 15 minute rest stop at Vail and arrival in Aspen is scheduled for approximately 11:30 P.M. THE ASPEN TRIP
February 20-27, 1965

Dear Member:

The officers of the Space City Ski Club have organized the following schedule and itinerary for a week's skiing in Aspen, Colorado, February 20-27, 1965. In order to benefit from economic rates on transportation, lodging, etc., we need a maximum number of club members to go along. Plans are presently made for:

TRANSPORTATION

Leave Houston by Chartered airplane at 5:00 AM February 20, 1965. A first class breakfast and beverages will be served on the flight. Upon arrival in Denver buses will be waiting at the airport to take us immediately to Aspen. Arrival time in Aspen will be approximately 1:00 PM. Departure time from Aspen will be sometime in the afternoon Saturday, February 27, for Denver. We will fly back to Houston and again an excellent dinner and drinks will be served. Arrival in Houston will be early Sunday morning.

LODGING

We have confirmed reservations for Fifty (50) people at the new Limelite Lodge in Aspen--putting 3-4 people in one room. More accommodations will be obtained if necessary. A Continental breakfast will be provided and the Limelite has a bar, a free coffee bar and is located in the heart of Aspen.

COST

Round trip transportation including buses from Houston-Denver-Aspen-Denver-Houston based on sixty-five (65) people is \$98 per person. If only fifty (50) people go round trip transportation is \$122, still far below commercial rates. The airplane will hold seventy-eight people. Lodging cost per person for seven nights is \$47. A deposit of \$40 per person is required to confirm our airplane and hold the motel accommodations. We must have your deposit by December 1, 1964. This deposit is refundable until January 1, 1965, if necessary, but after that time it is still transferable to some other person.

SKI RENTALS AND TOW TICKETS

Skis, boots and poles are available for rent at a nominal cost--approximately \$25-\$30 per week. A tow ticket for all lifts is \$33 per week.

Of course this Aspen Ski Trip is open only to members of the Space City Ski Club. We welcome anyone who wants to join our club and go along to Aspen with us. Let's all make plans NOW to spend one of the best week's vacation of your whole life. Round up your friends and let's go skiing!
