TRIP TO NEW ORLEANS - JUNE 25-27

We have planned a great weekend bus trip to New Orleans leaving Friday, June 25 about 6:00 p.m. and returning to Houston Sunday evening about midnight. We have scheduled a 42 passenger bus with bar and lavatory. We will fill that bus first and take a second one if sufficient persons sign up. It's a first come, first seated arrangement.

Accommodations are at the Monteleone Hotel in the heart of the French Quarter. We will arrive in New Orleans in time to chose the bars. Saturday morning is for sleeping, with the afternoon open for shopping, tours of the breweries, sunning at the rooftop poolside, antiqueing, picture-taking, portraits in Jackson Square, etc. Saturday evening will begin with informal drinks at the poolside bar, with the remainder open for dinner and revelry in the most famous nite-life district in the U.S. Sunday, perhaps breakfast at Brennan's and then leave about 3:00 p.m.
