NOVEMBER MEETING Monday, November 15, Hotel America Ballroom, Bar open at 7 pm, program begins 8;15. ASPEN TRIP Arrangements for the Aspen trip have been completed. We depart Houston Feb 5 and return Feb 13. Transportation is by chartered Constellation to Grand Junction with transfer to Aspen by bus. Accommodations are at the Continental Inn in 2,3,4, or 6 person rooms. Transportation cost is \$92.60 and room charges for seven nights are \$44.10, \$51.45, or \$66.15 per person depending on the room. We will accept deposits of \$50.00 at the meeting to reserve space for the trip. More details and an information sheet will be available at that time. Reservations are on a first come, first served basis up to the capacity of the plane (103). Talk to anyone who went to Aspen last year and you know that a good time was had by all.
